

WELCOME TO ACADEMIC INTERVENTION

Attendance is Mandatory

Each student must attend in order to improve academic success. Students can best learn when present on a regular basis. Attendance will be taken and recorded in the school database in the same manner as the typical school day. Missed classes result in missed information and diminished academic success. Lateness will result in a detention. You have 5 minutes to be on time to your support class.

The Code of Conduct in Effect

Be Responsible

Please avoid detentions for unpreparedness.

Effort can certainly yield positive results. Students who show up physically without being focused mentally will not benefit from this program.
