Dear Student and Parent/Guardian of Junior Class of 2025:

Welcome to your Junior year at Holy Cross. I am pleased to provide information that you will need for the start of your school year. The school day begins at 8:05 AM and ends at 2:30 PM. We will follow an 8 period schedule. We will adhere to all New York State health regulations.

Junior Class of 2025 - Orientation Day (dress code is in effect):

Friday, September 8, 2023 starting at 9:30 AM. Please Report to the Auditorium.

Students will meet with Campus Life in the Auditorium to review policies and procedures for the upcoming school year.

Junior Schedules: You may access your schedule online through your PowerSchool account. Schedules were created from the student's course requests, which parents approved last spring. **No changes** will be permitted.

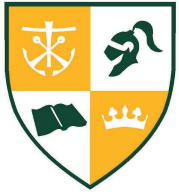
Monday, September 11, 2023 is the First Day of Classes for all students

Homeroom starts at 8:05 AM and the school day ends at 2:30 PM. The school dress code is in effect.

Remember it is important to establish a good routine for study, sleep and play. In the first cycle of schedule days 1 through 6, students will not be required to bring gym class apparel. Gym classes will review our Physical Education protocols. All Bookstore materials will be distributed during class. The total cost of your Bookstore purchase will be \$150, and for your convenience, unlike previous years, your Bookstore purchase will appear on your tuition account as a separate charge which is not part of the annual tuition.

Academic Reminders:

- Math courses require graphing calculators which are not available for purchase at the Holy Cross Bookstore. Recommended calculators are: TI-83, TI-83 plus, TI-84, TI-84 plus.
- Under the New York State Textbook Law, textbooks are loaned to students without cost. Students are responsible for returning these books at the end of the academic year. Students who do not return their textbook or return a damaged book, will be charged a replacement fee per book.
- **Student-Parent Handbook & Acknowledgement Forms** The 2023-2024 Student and Parent Handbook will be available on our website. The acknowledgement form will be provided during orientation day and must be completed and returned "**no later**" than Tuesday, September 12, 2023..
- **Summer Reading** Your child is responsible for the summer reading assignment. Summer reading is available at our website www.holycrosshs.org scroll down to "Additional Resources" Summer Reading. Students will have assignments and assessments on these books.

All official communication between the school and its families will be conducted via the aforementioned methods.

Tuition: All payments must be up-to-date in order for a student to attend classes starting on September 11, 2023 and to participate in any end of the summer athletic tryouts. Tuition payments should be made through Blackbaud Tuition Management (Smart Tuition).

Back to School Night for Parents is also very important. This event will take place on **Thursday, September 21 at 7:00 PM**. Schedules and other materials will be distributed at **6:30 PM**. Please arrive **on time**. Finding a parking space always takes time and you will have to pick up materials prior to the start of the program.

College Fair- will be held here at Holy Cross on **Monday, October 2 at 6:45 PM**. All are welcome!

Medical Office:

- Reminder: an updated **Child/Adolescent Health Medical Exam needs to be completed by your physician** and submitted to the medical office. Medical forms are available at www.holycrosshs.org scroll down to “Additional Resources” Medical Office, scroll down to “Health Office Forms”:

- **Immunizations required for the start of school:** We would like to take this time to remind everyone that vaccines are an integral part of keeping our school healthy. Vaccines protect children from getting and spreading diseases. There are a number of vaccine requirements for children attending school in NYS. It is important that you keep your child’s vaccine schedule up to date. Please check with your child’s pediatrician to make sure they have received all of their *required* vaccines. **If your child is missing required vaccines in September, our school nurse will notify you and you will have 14 days from the notification to get the vaccination, or your child will be excluded from attending school.**

Student Entrance: Students may use the secure designated entrances located on 169th Street or 170th Street. The building opens at 7:30 AM for all students and the Cafeteria is open at that time.

FamilyID Athletic Registration

Holy Cross is excited to announce that we are now offering the convenience of online registration through FamilyID (www.familyid.com). FamilyID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for our programs, and helps us to be more administratively efficient and environmentally responsible. When you register through FamilyID, the system keeps track of your information in your FamilyID profile. You enter your information only once for each family member for multiple uses and multiple programs.

ALL FAMILIES OF STUDENTS TRYING OUT FOR TEAMS MUST REGISTER:

Any student who plans to try out for any of our athletic teams must have their family establish an account with FamilyID in order to submit the *NYS Physical Examination Form* and the *Parent/Guardian Permission Form* electronically to Holy Cross. *Paper forms are no longer accepted.*

INFORMATION NEEDED TO REGISTER:

It will be helpful to have the following information handy to allow for the accurate completion of your online registration:

- Doctor information, Health Insurance Information, Student ID

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

A parent/guardian can register by clicking the Family ID link on the Holy Cross Athletics page on our website at www.holycorsshs.org

Registering as a new user on FamilyID is simple. Follow these steps:

1. If you have not already done so, create a FamilyID account by following the link on the athletics homepage.
2. After you sign up for an account please check your inbox for an Activation Email from FamilyID. You'll need to click the link in that email to activate your account.
3. Once you have activated your account, you will be ready to register for our program!
4. Click the blue Submit button. After selecting Submit, the registration will be complete. You will receive a completion email from FamilyID confirming your registration.

That is it! We now have a simple, quick, more modern and streamlined method of submitting medical paperwork.
