SPIROS MALIAGROS '94

Spiros Maliagros is President and a member of the board of the \$22B asset management business of AITi Tiedemann Global, a Nasdaq listed company. Spiros was the President of TIG Advisors for more than 15 years before it merged to create AITi. He joined the firm in 2006 as General Counsel assisting the Adviser with SEC registration and overseeing all legal matters for the firm. In June 2007, Spiros was appointed President to help with strategic initiatives for the Adviser and to oversee its day to day operations. Prior to joining the firm, Spiros worked for Seward & Kissel LLP representing and advising clients in the formation and distribution of domestic and offshore hedge funds, master-feeder funds and fund-of-funds pursuant to U.S. federal and state securities law from 2001 to 2006.

In 2014, Spiros was named "Lawyer of the Year" by the Hellenic Lawyers Association. He currently serves as Chairman of the Greek Division Board of Directors for the New York Ronald McDonald House and is Secretary of the Board of Directors of Holy Cross High School. Spiros has served on the parish council for the Archangel Michael Church in Port Washington and the finance advisory committee for the Manhasset School District.

An academically strong and well-rounded student at Holy Cross, Spiros spent all four years at Holy Cross on the swim team (captain, senior year), Student Government (president, senior year), Speech and Debate (president, senior year), Law Club (president, senior year), The Lance newspaper (editor, senior year) and Forensics Club (president, senior year). He was a member of the National Honor Society (president, senior year), participated in baseball and graduated as the Salutatorian of the Class of 1994.

Spiros went on to earn a B.A. in Government and Economics from Dartmouth College and a J.D. from Fordham University. Spiros and his wife Markella reside in Manhasset with their children Alexandra, Nicole and Leonida.

ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Established in 1983 by the alumni of Holy Cross High School, the Alumni Scholarship Fund supports full four-year scholarships based upon academic achievement to members of the Freshman Class. Criteria for eligibility are based upon TACHS exam scores with collaborative evidence from report cards to ensure that the student is in good standing. Scholarships are renewed each semester based upon maintenance of an overall average of 90% with no grade below 70%.

Recipients must also maintain an exemplary discipline record. This fund is supported annually through proceeds of the Holy Cross Golf and Dinner Classic.
